Over the last 10 years, mix-DJs from our programs have provided music at a variety of events and functions, with audiences ranging from 30 to 3000. Currently we are in the process of re-introducing DJing as 1 of the 3 tracks in Youth Radio's *Remix Your Life* artistic development program. The DJ Instructor will be responsible for teaching DJ classes, provide support for current *Remix Your Life* Staff and overseeing all in-house and mobile DJ gigs.

- Drive Youth Radio DJs and equipment to and from mobile DJ gigs.
- Support with data entry for relevant programming and events.
- Coordinate both in-house and community performance opportunities for DJ program participants.
- Coordinate in-house mentorship and skill building opportunities for participants.
- Cultivate relationships with relevant community organizations and individual stakeholders.
